## Proposal for Adventurous Projects

Definition: From the Record Book (page 14)

### c) **Adventurous Projects**

An Adventurous Project is a journey which does not fit the description of Expedition or Exploration exactly, or which may be a combination of the two. An Adventurous Project must be discussed with the Provincial / Divisional Director and approved on an individual basis. This is generally used by participants who would not find an Expedition or Exploration challenging enough or if for medical reasons could not do either an Expedition or an Exploration. **All Adventurous Projects require prior approval from your local Award office.**
