



ADVENTUROUS JOURNEY CHECKLISTS

Adventurous Journey 13 Requirements

1. A clearly defined aim (a purpose with a desired outcome)
2. No fewer than four and no more than seven participants in the group *
(eight for tandem travel)
3. Must have undergone suitable training
4. All participants must be involved with the planning and preparation of their Practice and Qualifying Journeys
5. Completed at least 1 Practice Journey *
6. Journey is through own physical effort, on land or water
7. New and unfamiliar environment chosen *
8. Minimum time spent on purposeful effort per day (6 hours at Bronze, 7 hours at Silver, 8 hours at Gold)
9. Suitable Assessor and Supervisor chosen
10. Sufficient equipment and supplies are packed and group equipment is shared out *
11. Accommodations are self-sufficient (tent, hut, etc.) with little or no amenities *
12. Substantial meal prepared and consumed each day of the journey
13. Report submitted to Assessor once completed

* COVID-19 accommodations in place until December 31 2022. Contact your Award Leader or Award Office for details and approval.

Participant Responsibilities

1. I will complete the required Preparation and Training before starting any other aspect of the Adventurous Journey
2. I will coordinate with group prior to journey
3. I will complete all required group work
4. I will organize and plan journey with assistance from Leader, Assessor, and supervisor
5. I will choose a route that is appropriate for my fitness/skill level
6. I will carry my own equipment and supplies
7. I will remain self-sufficient
8. I will take on a leadership role
9. I will prepare my own meals
10. I will coordinate with Assessor and check in when agreed upon
11. I will complete report and upload it on ORB



Supervisor Responsibilities

1. I understand that failure to set and implement clear boundaries may result in disqualification of the journey

2. I will act only as Supervisor for safety and risk management

3. I will complete the assessment of the Practice Journey

4. I will work closely with the Award Leader and Assessor prior to, following and during the Journey.

5. I will allow participant to remain independent and self-sufficient

6. I will ensure participant takes a leadership role

7. I will allow the participant to make decisions and solve problems

8. I will allow the participant to identify hazards and risks

9. I will allow the participant to test new skills and abilities in the following areas:

- Navigation
- Camp set-up
- Meal preparation
- Leave No Trace Camping



Assessor Responsibilities

1. I will coordinate check-ins (Do NOT need to be present on Journey)
2. I will ensure all 13 AJ Requirements are met by participant
3. I will ensure participant takes on a leadership role
4. I will review participant's report and make sure it is uploaded on ORB
5. I will complete assessment once confident participant has completed all requirements

Award Leader Responsibilities

1. I will ensure participant has completed all required Preparation and Training before starting any other part of the Adventurous Journey
2. I will coordinate with participant to organize group work
3. I will confirm with participant that route chosen will be sufficient
4. If Leader is Assessor: I will coordinate check-ins (Do NOT need to be present on Journey)
5. If Leader is not Assessor: I will ensure participant has appropriate Assessor
6. I will review participant's report and make sure it is uploaded on ORB
7. I will act as liaison with Award office and relay all relevant information to participant
