

Overview of Adventurous Journey Options

All journeys require a team of 4-8 peers and at least one adult delivering the Award to support you. Each level must include Planning and Preparation that ensures you can safely complete your Practice Journey (PJ) and Qualifying Journey (QJ).

Step 1: Choose the Award Level and Types of Journey

Choose the Award level(s) your team needs to complete and decide on the type of journey you want to complete. You can find information on AJ Requirements here.
