School Credit

Credit Recognition Process: Students can earn Special Project Credits (SPC) for completing levels of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

Steps:

1. Before starting the Award, students must submit a Special Project Credit Proposal to their school principal or Sask DLC. Template can be found in the Special Project Credit Policy https://pubsaskdev.blob.core.windows.net/pubsask-prod/84742/Special%252BProject%252BCredit%252BPolicy_2025-27.pdf or through your school district website.
2. Ensure the Award participation plan includes:
 - a. Minimum 100 hours of work
 - b. Clear educational outcomes and goals
 - c. A reflective activity (e.g., written report, presentation)
3. Project must not duplicate content from other credited courses and must be supervised by a qualified adult.
4. Once the project is complete, students submit final documentation to the school or DLC.

Potential Credit Equivalencies:

- Bronze: 1 credit
- Silver: 2 credits
- Gold: 3 credits

Note: Approval must be granted before work begins for SPC to be valid.
