Gold Project Requirements Checklist:

The Gold Project is the Gold Award's capstone. It supports meaningful goal setting and growth in leadership, teamwork, and reflection. The requirements ensure your project is immersive, purposeful, and guided by a mentor or Assessor. You can complete your Gold Project at any point after you register for the Gold level.

- ✓ Be away from home for at least 5 days and 4 nights (consecutive).
- ✓ Participate in purposeful activity that broadens your interests and experience.
- ✓ Work toward your goal with people who are new to you.
